The South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT) will hold a public meeting open house to discuss and receive public input on a traffic and drainage study for the area of S.D. Highway 38, between Burr Street and 413th Avenue, and S.D. Highway 38P from Wallace Street to S.D. Highway 38 in Mitchell. The purpose of this study is to evaluate existing and future conditions of the study area, with a focus on potential improvements related to safety and traffic operations along Highway 38 and drainage considerations along Highway 38P.

Staff from the SDDOT and consultant team will be available with displays to discuss the study and answer questions. The opportunity to provide written comments will be made available. Written comments will be accepted until Jan. 17, 2025.
