Highway Deficiencies

- Surfacing Age
- Intersection Alignment
- **Capacity**
- Crash Rate





> 2017 Average Daily Traffic (ADT) = 4983
> 2042 Projected ADT = 8221
> 11.5% Average Truck Traffic



Crash History

5 Year period from 2013 to 2017


- 54 Reported Crashes
 - 。16 Animal hit
 - 。12 Rear end
 - 。 8 Angle intersection
 - 。7 Fixed object off road
 - 2 Sideswipe overtake
 - 2 Sideswipe opposite direction
 - $_{\circ}$ 1 Head on
 - 。 6 other
- 17 Injury crashes (30 total injuries)
- 2 Fatal crashes (2 total fatalities)
- Reported crash rate = 2.26
- Rural Principal Arterial
 - Statewide weighted crash rate = 1.74 crashes per million vehicle miles of travel



Proposed Improvements


- Construct 4 lanes for capacity and safety
- 5 lanes through Rowena
- ½ mile full access from SD11 to 482nd
- ½ mile full access from 482nd to lowa
- Curb and gutter west of Rowena and in Rowena
- Replace culverts
- Bike/pedestrian path to Rowena
- Light all intersections and in Rowena








TYPICAL GRADING SECTION (in Rowena)

Access Management

- To provide safe, efficient access to streets and highways
- Limit number of direct accesses to major roadways



Right of Way (ROW)

- > Existing Width 100 feet
- Purchase additional ROW 100 feet for 200 feet total
- Temporary Easements as needed for construction



Encroachments

Encroachments - Private Property Located Within the Public ROW

- Federal Highway Regulations
- Safety
- > Examples of Encroachments
 - Signs
 - Private Use (Parking)
 - Landscaping Items

Owners of Encroachments will be Notified by the Sioux Falls Area Office



Utility Coordination

- Some Utilities may need to be relocated
- Utility Companies may negotiate easements with landowners as needed

Utility Coordination

- > Any Known Private Utilities?
 - Waterlines
 - Drainfields
 - Septic Tanks
 - Underground Storage Tanks

Environmental, Social & Economic Concerns

- A cultural resources survey will be conducted.
- The project is being reviewed to determine extent of wetland impacts.
- Endangered and Threatened Species:
 - Birds: Whooping Crane, Rufa Red Knot
 - Mammals: Northern Long-Eared Bat
 - Fish: Topeka Shiner
 - Plants: Western Prairie Fringed Orchid




Construction Traffic Control

- SD42 will likely be closed to through traffic during construction
- > Through traffic will be detoured to alternate routes
- Local traffic and emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times


